Housing Development Update

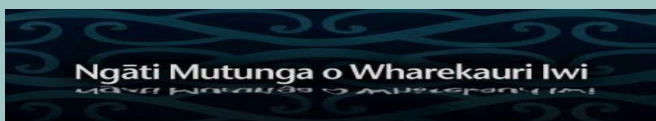
- CIET has gifted land at Sandstone to the Partnership Trust to develop into housing.
- There will be 5 x 3-bedroom dwellings.
- A "Breaking Ground Blessing" will be held at Sandstone on 15th March 2021, at 7am.
- Scheduled to commence building in May 2021, completed later in the calendar year.
- Housing support plans will be offered – need to have completed Sorted Kainga Ora.
- Preference for first time homeowners.

Housing Support

We will be focused on offering a "Rent to Buy" scheme. This is a more affordable option for whanau to become first time homeowners post covid-19.

- Under this scheme, whanau will rent the houses but provided with a pathway to buying and owning the houses over time.
- Financial criteria will apply to help ensure whanau can manage the commitment over the long term.
