WHAT'S HAPPENING?

We've reached the final stage of Treaty settlement negotiations with the Crown. The Initialled Deed of Settlement (iDOS) is ready for you to review.

Our roadshow is your chance to:

- Hear what's in the proposed settlement package
- Ask questions and share your whakaaro
- Find out what happens next

Be assured you are not being asked to endorse the settlement in this hui.
That's the next stage ratification hui which will run from May 2026.

WHAT'S IN THE SETTLEMENT?

Total Value: \$18 million

(\$5m Cultural Redress, \$13m Financial & Commercial Redress)

Crown Apology:

For past breaches and failures

Cultural Redress:

Legal recognition of our connections to whenua, wāhi tapu, and significant sites

Property Redress:

Property redress provides the opportunity to acquire specified Crown properties through deferred selection and purchase.

Shared Redress:

Some redress is shared with Moriori, including Te Whāngā Lagoon and Tikitiki sites

Relationship Redress:

Agreements with Crown agencies to support our future

Right of First Refusal:

First opportunity to purchase certain Crown properties

Governance:

If ratified, all assets and redress will be managed by a Post-Settlement Governance Entity (PSGE) accountable to whānau
